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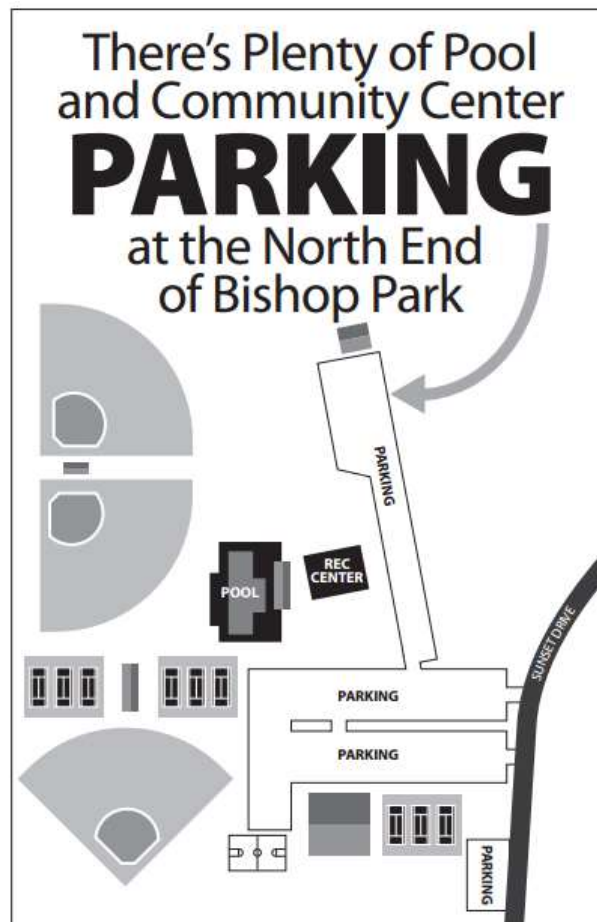
Facility: The 2018 Oconee Swim League Championship Meet will be held at Bishop Park, located at 705 Sunset Drive Athens, GA 30606

Please observe the following facility rules:

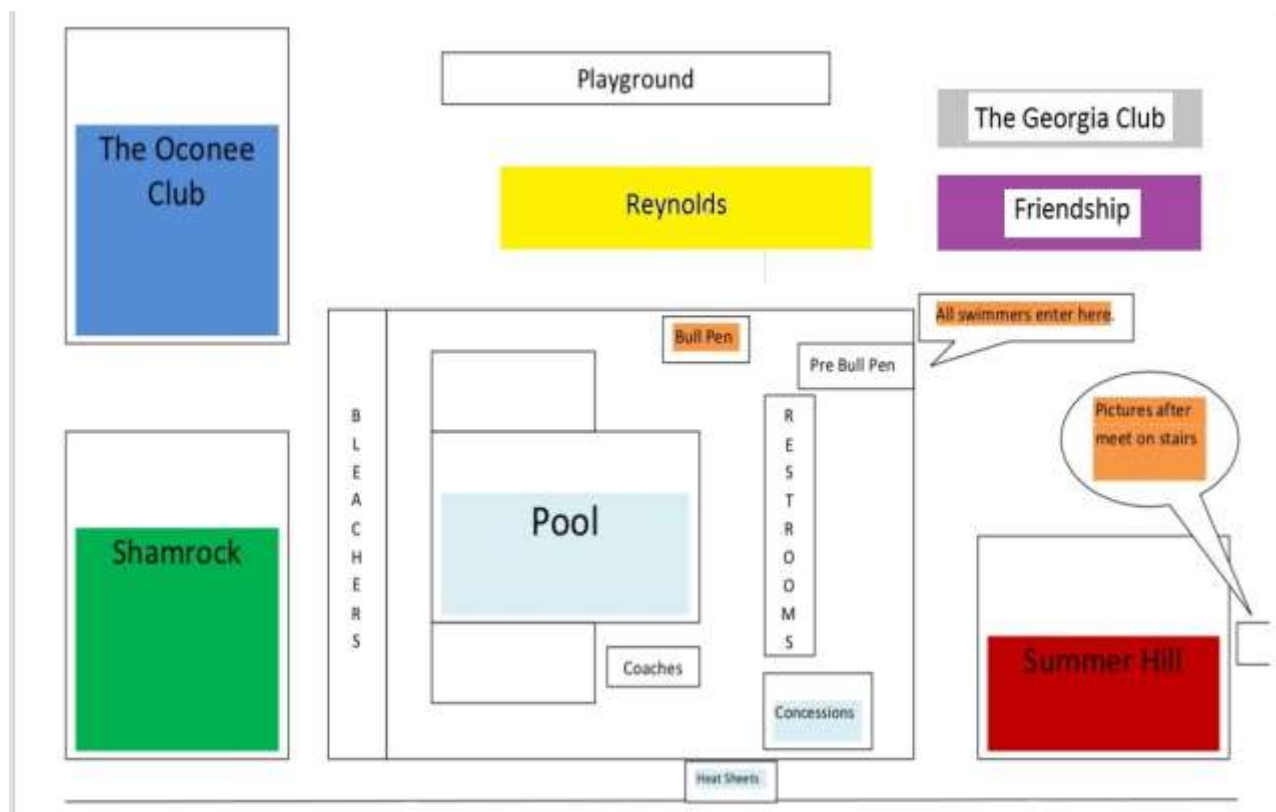
- All children must be directly supervised at all times including trips to the restrooms.
- No outside food or drink may be brought onto the pool deck.
- Only water bottles will be permitted on the pool deck – no food or other drinks.
- Tobacco products and alcohol are not allowed in the park.
- Only swimmers, coaches and event volunteers are permitted on the pool deck.

Supplies: Don't forget, you may want to bring an extra set of goggles and a swim cap as well as an activity or two to keep swimmers busy between their races. Each team will have an assigned setup area. Parents can bring tents, coolers, etc. It is an outside facility, so bring plenty of drinks and snacks.

Parking: Parking will be limited and the Athens Farmers Market will also take place on Saturday morning. Feel free to come early. Please carpool, if at all possible. FAST will confirm the possibility of parking at the VFW.



Seating: Each team has assigned setup area for the meet. These sections will be clearly marked. There are bleachers, along the far side of the pool. We are asking that everyone be considerate and let parents watching their swimmers sit in the bleachers. When your swimmer is finished, please make room for other parents.



Heat Sheets: Heat Sheets will be available for sale at the front gate from 6:45 am - 8:45 am at a cost of \$5.00.

First Aid: First aid will be available at any of the lifeguard stands or in the lifeguard office located on the pool deck.

Concessions: There will be concessions that include Chick-Fil-A biscuits and sandwiches, Powerade, water, soda, candy, and other snacks.

Pictures: Photos of the following, will be taken at the conclusion of the meet on the stairs at the far end of Summer Hill's area right outside entrance of the pool:

- A team picture will be taken of the championship team.
- A picture will also be taken of individual swimmers who set a new county record in an event.
- A picture will also be taken of those relays that set a new county record.

Meet Results: Results will be posted on the walls near the restrooms for spectators and on the pool deck near the lifeguard office for the swimmers and coaches.

Scoring:**Team Scoring:**

- The meet will score 3 swimmers per team, per individual event
- A team may only have one relay team score per relay event.

Individual events, placement and scoring:

- The top 6 swimmers score points (the top 8 receive ribbons).
 - First place = 7 points
 - Second place = 5 points
 - Third place = 4 points
 - Fourth place = 3 points
 - Fifth place = 2 points
 - Sixth place = 1 point

Relay events, placement and scoring:

- The top 4 swimmers score points (the top 6 receive ribbons).
 - First place = 9 points
 - Second place = 5 points
 - Third place = 3 points
 - Fourth place = 1 points

Tied times:

- In the event of a tie, the points for the two places will be averaged and awarded. Two awards for the higher of the 2 places will be given in the event of a tie.

Cleanup: All assistant coaches and any other volunteers are asked to help clean up immediately following the final event. Lane ropes will need to be removed, bullpen chairs stacked and put away, tents/chairs/tables removed, trash picked up, etc.
